



Aircraft Deconstruction Technicians

Aerocycle is currently hiring technicians to assist us in the recycling of wide-body and narrow-body transport category aircraft at our Mirabel (CYMX) location. The position is part-time/casual. Retired or semi-retired candidates are accepted. Candidates will work under the supervision of the Aircraft Maintenance Engineers and the Aircraft Maintenance Technicians.

Duties shall include, but are not limited to:

- Adhere to and follow the company's policies and procedures.
- Remove aircraft interior, galleys, lavatories, insulation material, floor covering, floor panels, aircraft wiring bundles and connectors.
- Remove cargo linings, floor panels, insulation material, wiring bundles and connectors.
- Remove equipment and avionics racking.
- Assist the AMEs, aircraft technicians and heavy equipment operators in the final deconstruction of the aircraft by controlling debris and cleaning the work site.
- Clean and maintain the workplace.

Candidates must meet the following requirements:

- Must be mechanically inclined.
- Ability for manual work and working with tools.
- Possess a driver's licence.
- Ability to work in Canada.
- Possess a Restricted Area Identification Card (RAIC) or have the ability to obtain one.
- No criminal record.
- Ability to work with minimal supervision.
- Ability to communicate in English and French (preferred).
- Ability to read and write in English.
- Provide own transportation to Mirabel Airport.
- Be willing to work outside in all weather conditions.
- Ability to work at heights.
